## How secure is your job?

"There are rumors about a probable retrenchment. I thought they were just rumors, so I ignored them. I did not think that it would really happen. I have recently accepted a similar position with another employer. I hope this job will be more secure, but I'm worried it won't be."

"If I am aware that my job is insecure, what should I do?"

Do these voices sound familiar to you? A company might lay off employees or not fill vacancies because it has become more efficient, or because it has lost market share and cannot sell a certain range of its products or services.

Multitasking is one of the trends in the smaller companies where employees usually wear more than one hat. More companies are shuffling their staff around and job responsibilities may change as a result. This would mean that companies today require more well-rounded, competent and efficient employees.
